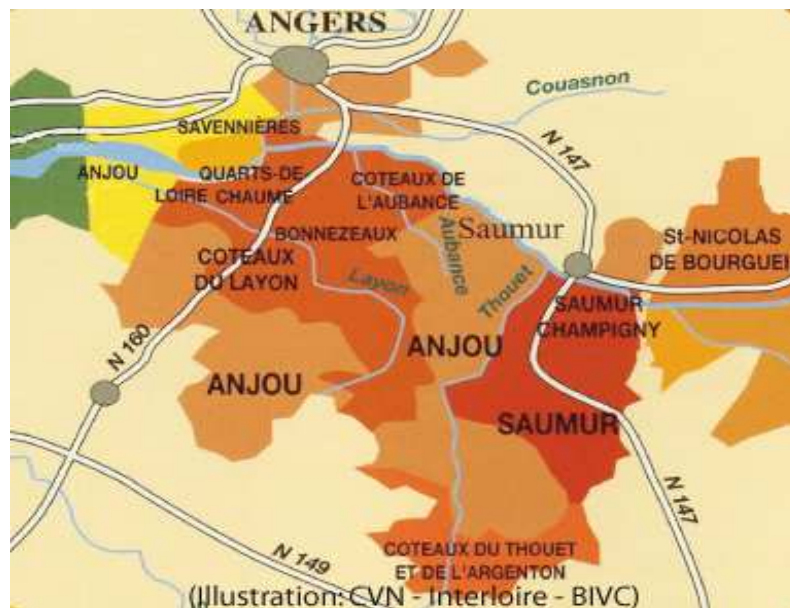


# APPELLATION MAP

Harvest is done strictly by hand and sustainable practices are used throughout the year. The objective is to ensure high quality fruits by controlling the production levels and the health of the vine.
