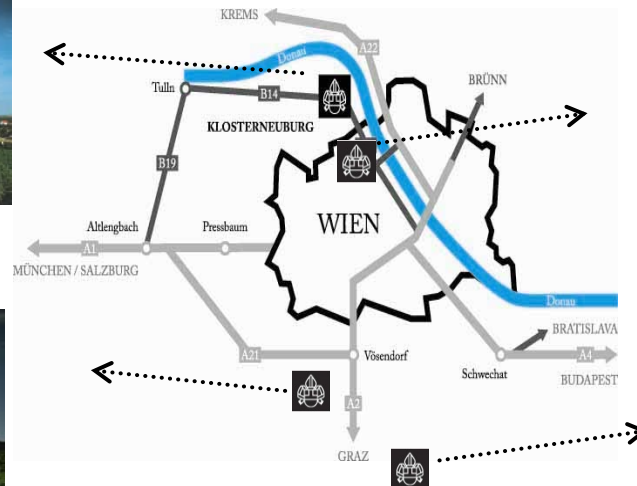

Klosterneuburg

- 10 km north of Vienna along the river Danube
- 25 Hectars
- Soil: Sandstone, Loess and conglomerate
- Grüner Veltliner, Riesling, Sauvignon blanc



Vienna

- Vineyards in the northwestern part of the city
- 25 Hectars
- Soil: Limestone
- Weissburgunder (Pinot Blanc), Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Gewürztraminer, „Gemischter Satz“
- Temperature regulation through the river Danube



Gumpoldskirchen

- 20 km south of Vienna
- 5 Hectars
- Soil: Limestone and brown earth
- Zierfandler, Rotgipfler,
- Mild, pannonian climate



Tattendorf

- 25 km south of Vienna
- 55 Hectars
- Soil: Alluvial limestone gravel with brown earth
- St. Laurent, Zweigelt, Blaufränkisch, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot
- „Stiftsbreite“ is Austria's largest single vineyard



Vinification in baroque cellar

- Processing of all grapes takes place in Klosterneuburg
- Historic but state of the art wine cellars 4 levels deep below the monastery
- Time & unique atmosphere



What we produce:

- **2 wine lines:**
 - Klassik wines
 - Single Vineyard wines
- **Sparkling wines:**
 - Klostersekt: fresh, fruity, typically Austrian
 - MATHÄI brut: Méthode traditionnelle
- **Natural, cloudy varietal apple juices**
- **Fine spirits:** (St. Laurent XO, St. Laurent „Grappa“, Apple, Williams pear, Apricot)
- **Specialities:** St. Laurent grape seed oil, St. Laurent vinegar, wine gelee, St. Laurent chocolate, etc.



Klassik wines



- Maximum varietal character and regional typicity
- Fruit-driven, high drinking pleasure
- 100% grapes from our own vineyards, always from one appellation
- Vinification in stainless steel



Single Vineyard wines



- Flagship wines which express the unique character of their terroir
- Famous single vineyards, low yields, meticulous grape selection
- Ageing in big oak casks or in barriques
- Release: 2 years after harvest



St. Laurent - our flagship grape

- St. Laurent: a relative of Pinot Noir
- 1st planted in Klosterneuburg in mid 1800s
- Our single vineyard „Stiftsbreite“ is the world’s largest St. Laurent vineyard

Vienna: Wine & the City

- The only capital city in the world with viticulture (600ha)
- Wiener Gemischter Satz DAC: Accessible terroir wine
- Several grape varieties grow together in one vineyard
- Harvested together, crushed together, fermented together
=> one multifaceted wine

A slightly spicy aroma of citrus, green apples and pepper, of medium strength in terms of body and with a harmonious spicyness.

Zierfandler-Rotgipfler



Opulent and complex in its aroma, this Cuvée reminds one of tropical fruits, presenting itself as juicy, complex and of nearly baroque extravagance on the palate

Weissburgunder Jungherrn



Expressive flavours of ripe apples and hints of pineapple and dry fruit. Elegant extract sweetness, notes of biscuits and juicy body is presented on the palate. This wine impresses with complexity and very good balance with elegant, delineated acid structure.

Finely fruity acidity and clearness. Deep ruby-red, fine blackberry and plum fragrances, good length.

Coloured deep ruby red and with an aroma subtly reminiscent of fully ripened sour cherries and cherries, it presents itself to the palate as consummately homogenous, fruity and juicy.

St. Laurent Ausstich



Deep ruby-pomegranate colouration, hints of star anise and gingerbread, and fine cherry and sour cherry notes make it a particularly elegant representative of its variety. A red wine with balance and velvety texture which leaves one waxing enthusiastic.

Welschriesling Eiswein

Intense tropical fruit aromas and a lively acidity make it an exceptional sweet wine with great potential. This wine impresses with complexity and very good balance with elegant, delineated acid structure.
