

**"Every Pig has its St. Martin's Day"**



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## Celler el Masroig 2012 VI NOVELL

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Each year, in Europe, 'San Marti' (Saint Martin) is celebrated on the 11th of November.

*Saint Martin was a monk who founded the 1st monastery in Western Europe and in Spain it is tradition to slaughter the fattened pigs for the winter on this date. The saying, "Every pig has its St. Martin's Day" refers to this tradition but also means "Every sinner will have its day."*

The wine is a blend of 40% Carignan, 40% Grenache and 20% Syrah. It is fermented by the method of 65% carbonic maceration which leads to its unique and appealing style. Initial intense red fruits of strawberries and raspberries on the nose lead into aromas of blueberries, banana, Mediterranean herbs and subtle earthy notes.

It is light to medium bodied with fresh fruit flavors and hints of chocolate and cocoa.

The extremely fruity finish is coupled with balanced acidity.
